Current status of ETO and next steps

Brief overview of Annual Meeting Plans

Member Needs Assessment



- April 2008 EPA issues re-registration eligibility decision maintaining spice usage contingent on reproductive and developmental studies
- June 2008 waiver request denied
- November 2008 ASTA meets with EPA to present data developed by toxicologist

- March 2009 EPA waives request for prenatal development study but not reproductive & fertility effects
- April 2009 Board decides study must be funded by users based on volume
- May 2009 form sent to record volume of ETO treated spice traded by companies

 September 2009 – assessment amounts calculated, distributed for review and decision on whether to contribute

 October 13 – ASTA Board of Directors reviews funding commitments – will proceed with study. First year invoices to be mailed in next month



Study results due December 2011.
 Expect to be favorable based on data review conducted by toxicologist

 ETO re-registration will be good through 2018 (ten years from re-registration eligibility decision)
