The Format & Some Rules

Gentlemen please use the White tees; Ladies please use the Red Tees. We have chosen a scramble format to give each team an equal opportunity to win this tournament. The handicap of each team will be the total of all players' handicaps divided by 6. Your team handicap has already been calculated and is on the team's score card. Each team of 4 is **required** to use a minimum of three (3) tee shots from each player during the round, if you do not record this, another fine will be on the way and possible DQ! **Par 3s do count**. Each team is to note the player's drive that was chosen on the score sheet. If you are a team of 3 then you need to take 4 tee shots each. All you need to do is record the number of strokes you took on each hole, add them up and take off the exact team handicap. **(Not doing so will mean a DQ)**.

In the event of a 3-person team, one member of the threesome may, <u>on a rotational basis by hole</u>, take the extra shot to compensate for the fourth person, but they do this for the whole of the hole. To help with the organization please do not ask for any last-minute changes to the printed teams.
