6	SEC. 2. FINDINGS; PURPOSE.
7	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds as follows:

- 11 Section 301 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
- 12 Act (21 U.S.C. 331) is amended by adding at the end the
- 13 following:
- 14 "(fff) Selling, or offering to sell, directly to con-
- 15 sumers a food that is or contains poppy seeds, including
- 16 concentrates, metabolites, constituents, or extracts of
- 17 poppy seeds, that contain levels of morphine, codeine, or
- 18 other alkaloid compounds that may render the food inju-
- 19 rious to health.".
