Food Safety Modernization Act

- Obama signs into law on January 4, 2011
- Many changes in the food industry which will affect Domestic and International members
 - New responsibilities for food companies
 - New controls over imported foods
 - New and enhanced FDA enforcement powers
 - New fees on food companies and importers



Key Provisions Tiered Implementation

- Effective Immediately
 - Mandatory Recall Authority, Imported Food Notifications, Inspections of Facilities
- Effective 18 months
 - HACCP, Product Tracing Systems,
 Administrative Detention, Import Certificate,
 Inspection of Company records
- Effective 2 years
 - Foreign Supplier Verification Plan, Laboratory
 & Third Party Auditor Accreditation
