### Re-Registration

- Biennial every two years in even numbered years
- October 1 December 31
- Guidance to be issued
- Voluntary collection of facility profile information is possible
- Originally scheduled to begin last week
- Postponed indefinitely



#### Re-Registration

"While FDA was poised to roll out a new outreach program to notify U.S. and foreign food facilities of their new responsibility, the agency issued a short notice Sept. 28 saying it could not accept renewals and could not provide the date when its registration website will be live.

The reason for the delay? "The agency is still working to finalize related guidance documents and implement certain policies and processes," FDA says.

# FSMA Update Implementation & Compliance

#### FDA Actions This Past Year

- FDA Frequently Asked Questions
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report to Congress
- IFR & guidance records access
- Food Safety Preventive Controls Alliance (FSPCA)



#### FDA 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report

- Close to 20,000 domestic inspections
- Almost 1,000 foreign inspections
   (up from 357 in FY 2011)
- Identified over 22,000 domestic food firms as high risk
  - Almost half (11,007) inspected in FY 2011



#### FDA 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report

Average costs of facility inspections:

\$21,100 high-risk

\$14,200 non high-risk

\$24,800 foreign
