ASTA/FDA Shared Goal

Clean Safe Spice

- Risk of pathogen contamination
- Responsible companies mitigate risk
- Entire industry is impacted by outbreaks
- ASTA takes responsibility for moving entire industry forward



ASTA Philosophy

- Work cooperatively with FDA
- Represent industry views
- Provide constructive input
- Achieve shared goal of clean safe spice with minimal disruption and cost to industry



ASTA Actions

- Ongoing dialogue with FDA
- Federal Register Notice
 - Working Group & Ed Ruckert evaluated request
 - Members submitted data on 58,000 lots
 - Informed FDA we cannot provide requested data on:
 - Consumption patterns
 - Manufacturing practices with intended use



ASTA Actions

- Work underway on second submission
 - Filth data
 - Overview of supply chain and control steps
 - Overview of paths spices take to consumers



Additional ASTA Initiatives

- ASTA organized educational visits to member companies
 - Tours and presentations on sourcing
- Key questions
 - How well do companies know suppliers?
 - Where and when is treatment done?
 - When is pathogen testing done?
 - How is decision made to treat?
 - Have processes been validated?



ASTA Role

- Provide industry knowledge
- Work cooperatively to identify problems and implement solutions
- Ensure industry concerns are addressed
- Achieve shared goal of clean safe spice

- Take more proactive role
