Susan L. Abbott earned a B.A., in chemistry from St. Joseph's College in Emmitsburg, Maryland, a masters in engineering administration from George Washington University in Washington, D.C., and a Ph.D. in Policy Sciences at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

Ms. Abbott was an active member of the American Spice Trade Association (ASTA). She served as ASTA president from 1998 to 2000 and before her term Ms. Abbott served on numerous committees including: Government Relations where she served as chair, the Ethylene Oxide Project Committee, and the Pesticide Project Committee. She also helped create the International Organization of Spice Associations (IOSTA) working with Codex Alimentarius on the establishment of pesticide MRLs on spices using monitoring data.
